Basic Info

It is recommended that students bring their own hand tools. Studio tools are used by many classes so they get quite a lot of use and may not be in optimum shape. It is essential that you be able to see details of your work so visual aids such as reading glasses, Optivisors, or similar things are recommended.

Basic Tool Kit

- Half round file, #0 Swiss cut or similar
- Half round file, #2 Swiss cut or similar
- Pliers: chain, round, flat
- Flush cutters
- Sand paper-320, 400, 600
- Paint stir sticks or half round wood molding for making sanding sticks (paint stir sticks are sometimes free in hardware store if you ask)
- Needle file set
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Sharpie
- Scissors
- Masking tape
- Clear packing tape
- Small containers for solder chips
- Rubber gloves
- Paper for drawing and notes
- Face mask
- Eye protection
