Masami Teraoka can see mountains from his Windward home and studio. In printing *Pali Lookout*, he was influenced by Japanese ukiyo-e woodblock prints. Visible in the piece's essential flatness are the soft gradations of colors, the linear outlines of the mountain forms, and the sky shading from light to dark.

Robert Lobe is inspired by shapes, materials, and textures found in the woods. He depicts rocks and trees in shimmering hollow forms using heat-treated hammered aluminium. Harmony Ridge, where this sculpture was made, is a public campground in northern New Jersey.
