- 1-2 mud tools, metal paisley shape serrated rib
- Any favorite detailing tools
- 1- wire clay cutter
- 1-dowel style rolling pin
- An assortment of scoring tools
- 1-D"s texturing tool, available at The Ceramic Hobbyist
- 1- Quality chopstick
- 1- Wooden rice paddle, or flat wooden spoon
- 1- Round brush, white nylon bristle size 6, available at Ben Franklin

## **Painting Supplies**

- A pallet of assorted Duncan E-Z strokes under glazes
- Your favorite liner brushes
